

Kids at Camp—Parent Information

Supervision of Children:

- Children 12 and under need to be enrolled in Kids Camp or supervised by an adult at all times. No exceptions. This is both for safety reasons and liability.
- Make agreements with other parents to supervise your child if you need to. (Don't just assume that your child will be watched by others in the community—it is really not a happy situation for anyone when something goes wrong with a child and nobody knows where their parent or guardian is.)

Kids, Tweens, and Teens Camp:

- **Parent Meeting and Orientation:** Takes place Saturday, June 19 from 8:45-9:45am on the lawn outside of the dining hall.
- **Kids Camp Location:** The kids (4-7 years old) meet at the cabin to the left on the hill across from the dining hall. There will be a string marking the boundaries and a sign on or above the door.
- **Tweens Camp Location:** The tweens (8-12 years old) meet at the art pavilion, which is on the hill between the kid's camp cabin and the pond/dance pavilion area. (It's an open-air pavilion with picnic tables.)
- **Teens Camp Location:** The teens meet at the pond on the beach or the dock, only in the afternoon.
- **Hours:** AM Session: 9:45-12:30pm; PM Session: 2:15-6:00pm

Kid's Cozy Room: The Kid's Cozy Room is located in the first room on the left off the backside door of the dining hall. This is an area where you can let your children take naps or fall asleep during the nighttime boogies. However, remember that they must be supervised.

Tweens/Teens Chill Room: The Tweens and Teens Chill Room is located in the middle room on the right of the back deck behind the kitchen. It is available for tweens and teens to hang out and just chill. (Please remember that tweens **do** need to be supervised by an adult at all times at camp, even while in the chill room) There are some games and books available, as well as a TV/VCR. (Please, bring only videos that are suitable for all ages and sensitivities as this is a shared room and group experience.)

The Pond and Waterfront Safety:

- 12 and under need adult supervision at pond, even when lifeguard is present.
- 17 and under need adult supervision at the pond when no lifeguard is present.
- 17 and under need to wear a life jacket at all times, while in the canoe.
- 15 and under need to be two in a canoe.
- There will be a lifeguard on duty in the afternoon between 2:30-5:30.
